



Sports Premium Funding 2014 - 15

The Government is providing additional funding of £150 million per annum until 2020 to improve provision of PE and sport in primary schools. This equates to £9,360 for our school for this year.

In 2014 - 15 we allocated the funding in the following ways:

Annual Subscription to SDCC Sports Partnership Organisation and running of inter-school and intra-school sports events. Organisation and running of CPD courses to meet the demand of local schools. Termly meetings to address issues-share good practice amongst schools.	£1,200

As an outcome from our sport and PE focus we have:

- Staff with increased confidence and skill in delivering the Physical Education curriculum
- Increased progress within the Physical Education for pupils evidenced within lessons, by pupils working to exceed their personal bests, as well as outcomes of competitive events.
- A significant improvement in the number of pupils participating in sports clubs
- Increased opportunities for pupils to take part in intra school events, with the ultimate aim that 100% of children take part
- An increased number of festivals and competitions entered by the school
- Raised profile of our school as a keen participant in a wide range of sporting events

We have part of our website specifically devoted to celebrating sport and PE at Dartington and a termly publication, Sport Eye, created by our Sport and Dance Leaders which gives a flavour of how Sports Premium Funding has been used to maximum advantage in our school.
