



Sports Premium Funding 2016 – 17

The Government is providing additional funding of £150 million per annum until 2020 to improve provision of PE and sport in primary schools. This equates to £9,130 for our school for 2016 – 17.

In we allocated the funding in the following ways:

As an outcome from our sport and PE focus we have:

- Staff applied increased confidence and skill in delivering the Physical Education curriculum
- Staff specialist skills were utilised, specifically in dance, with Gifted and Talented pupils supported towards performances
- Progress maintained within the Physical Education for pupils evidenced within lessons, by pupils working to exceed their personal bests, which remained a focus.
- There was a reduction in the range of clubs available, but the number of pupils participating in sports clubs available remained steady
- School targeted pupil groups for engagement within the school day
- There was a targeted approach to festivals and competitions entered by the school, such as Cyclocross, Cross County and Ability Games
- Leaders ensured that festivals and competitions were part of a termly focus so that pupils were well prepared and to ensure an ongoing profile of our school as a keen participant in sporting events
