9.	Safeguarding & Attendance	
1	<u>Safeguarding:</u> JM reported that a fixed-term off-site exclusion was issued on the day of the E-visit. A variety of external agencies have acknowledged that there are two pupils whose needs cannot be met in a mainstream school, however EHCPs have stated that they can. Good parental engagement continues with part-time timetables in place. PIPs training is being explored and could be revisited for all staff (£400 cost). Risk Assessments have been updated and the school is managing as well as possible.	
2	<u>Attendance:</u> AP reported that Attendance codes have been updated and overall attendance now stands at 93.4% which is very low (target 96%). 1.5-2% of absence this year was due to the 'flu after Christmas & without this attendance would have been at 94.9%. Medical appointment absence benchmarks high, but are legitimate. Close monitoring of all absence codes is ongoing.
